

CROCHET WITH CARL

“Bundled Up” Scarf



Materials: 200 yards of Worsted weight yarn
(I used 2 skeins of Berroco “Geode”)

Appropriately sized crochet hook (H)

Tapestry needle to weave in ends

SCARF:

Ch 21.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook; Sc in each ch across to end. 20 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1 and turn. Sc in each of first 4 sc.
*Ch 5, skip next 4 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * across.

Row 3-4: Ch 1 and turn. Sc in each of first 4 sc.
*Ch 5, skip next 5-ch space, sc in each of next 4

sc; rep from * across.

Row 5: Ch 1 and turn. Sc in each of first 4 sc. *Ch 2, sl st over *all three* 5-ch loops of last 3 rows, ch 2, sc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * across.

Row 6: Ch 1 and turn. Sc in each of first 4 sc. *Ch 5, skip over bundled chains, sc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * across.

Repeat Rows 3-6 until scarf reaches desired length, ending with Row 5.

Next Row: Ch 1 and turn. Sc in each of first 4 sc. *Ch 4, skip over bundled chains, sc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * across.

Final Row: Ch 1 and turn. Sc in each of first 4 sc. *4 sc in ch-4 space, sc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * across.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
