

CROCHET WITH CARL

“Windows” Scarf



Materials: 180-200 yards of Worsted or Aran weight yarn
(one skein of Universal Yarn's "Classic Shades")
Appropriately sized crochet hook (J)
Tapestry needle to weave in ends

Ch 19.

Foundation Row: Sc in third ch from hook. Sc in each st to end. Ch 3 (counts as dc) and turn.

Row 2: Skip first st. Dc in next st. [Ch 3. Skip next three sc, dc in each of next two sts.] Repeat to end of row, working last dc in top of turning chain. Ch 2 (counts as sc) and turn.

Row 3: Skip first dc. Sc in next dc. [3 sc in ch3 space. Sc in each of next two dc.] Repeat to end of row, working last sc in top of turning chain. Ch 3 (counts as dc) and turn.

Row 4: Skip first sc. Dc in each st to end of row, working last dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3 (counts as dc) and turn.

Repeat rows 2-4 until scarf is desired length, ending with Row 3. Fasten off and weave in ends.
